New Year, New Roles



In 2015, when Matt first joined NewThing and began apprenticing as the Regional Director for Sub-Saharan Africa, there was an agreement between all parties involved that within approximately 5 years the role would be turned over to an indigenous African. It's been six and a half years since then and that desired result has now come to fruition.

Last year Matt began apprenticing Pastor Gbenga Sanya of Lagos, Nigeria to be the next Regional Director for Sub-Saharan Africa. That apprenticeship is now in the final few stages as Gbenga is being officially ushered into that role as of today.

Matt will be stepping into a newly created role within NewThing - the Global Operation Director. In that role Matt will be responsible for helping to streamline the organization as he works through the Regional Directors around the world to setup strategies, systems, and structures for scalability and sustainability.

Matt and TaLarrya will continue to live and serve in Nairobi, Kenya.

TaLarrya is also stepping into a new initiative as 2022 starts. As she continues to give leadership to CovenantLight Church (pictured here with some of her disciples) she will also be working towards launching GOAL (Global Organization for Apostolic Leadership), which will be a non-profit organization under the umbrella of CovenantLight.

GOAL will be aimed at finding, training, developing and releasing church planters around the world. The hope is to equip leaders to be better positioned to start church planting movements in their local context.





Israel Trip March 13-26, 2023

If a participant is going on the trip alone, double accommodations can be selected instead of single, and they will be paired with someone who is the same age and gender. This would be a significant savings. When you arrive in Ben Gurion airport in Tel Aviv (there is only one airport in Israel) there are sheruts (taxis) waiting, a \$25 taxi fee to Jerusalem will take you to the Jaffa Gate. The Gloria Hotel is a one minute walk from the Jaffa Gate.

Passport: You need a valid passport to participate. Your passport cannot expire within 6 months of the travel return date.

Flight information: I did a bit of research on airfare on Scott's Cheap Flights. I made an inquiry to this organization, they said the best "window" for a cheap flight to Israel is 2-8 months before departure. As I am a member, they alert me to great deals! More on this later...

Deposit: If you are joining us, a \$250 non refundable deposit per person is due by 9/1/22. This is paid to Fulton Church. It can be a check, or paid through Breeze with a debit or credit card. There would be a processing fee to pay with credit or debit. The remainder of the fee is due to Jerusalem University College 30 days before the start date (approximately Feb 10, 2023). Jerusalem University College has a North American office in Marion, OH. I can supply their contact information later.

Map Study: Once the deposit is received, JUC will send out maps for each participant, and we will have two meetings in the fall at Fulton Church to study together, field questions, etc.

Bible reading– As this excursion is just over a year away, you could challenge yourself to read through the Bible before we go! http://www.thebiblerecap.com/start This is a motivating way to go about it, it takes you through in one year, and there is a daily podcast that provides insight into the daily readings.
