Highlights of the Lord's Work

The end of a semester is a good time to reflect on the work of the Lord. While there are many fun moments to look back upon, some stand out as points of growth. Three areas of growth are highlighted below.

Every week, InterVarsity students gather on Thursday night for time in God's word, prayer, worship, and fellowship. For years, attendance at our large group gathering has remained relatively the same year-to-year. This year, the number of students attending on a weekly basis has increased to the highest average attendance in a decade. Students are craving community and connection and are finding that through our large group gatherings.

Even as large group attendance increases, the Lord is still at work in powerful ways in our small group Bible studies. In recent years, we have enjoyed fruitful Bible studies in Wells East, one of UW-Whitewater's largest residence halls. But this year, we are seeing a new season of kingdom fruitfulness there. Members of the group invited friends, who also invited friends, and now 15 students meet weekly to study the Bible in Wells East! We're exploring ways to adapt in order to serve students better as the number of those interested in studying the Bible grows.



Each semester, our chapter hosts a prayer room where students sign up for hour-long time slots and collectively pray for more hours than any individual could alone. This semester, over the two days our prayer room spanned, InterVarsity students prayed for more hours than any previous prayer room. But setting that record was less important than watching the resurgence of prayer that has occurred after a slow start in September. More students than ever are investing time in communal prayer, both in the prayer room and in our daily prayer meetings. In the past, prayer growth has always preceded a new work of the Lord, and I can't wait to see what He will do next.

The Lord is at work in powerful ways on campus at UW-Whitewater. As we look forward to next semester, we are eagerly anticipating what He will do next. Will you join us in praying for more fruitfulness as we take steps of faith?





Welcome, Dena Casper, Our New Youth Director!

At the beginning of this year, Dena Casper officially stepped into the role of Youth Director, and I (Pastor Zack) couldn't be more excited to welcome her to our staff team here at Fulton Church.

I've truly loved working with our incredible students over the past five years. It has been such a gift to walk alongside these teens and to be a small part of what God has been doing in them and through them. I deeply cherish the memories we've shared—Varsity nights, mission trips, winter camps, sports events, plays, meaningful conversations, theological debates, and so much more.

With Dena joining our team, my role will be shifting slightly. I'll now be working alongside Josh Bilhorn to help form an Outreach Team. This team will focus on how we, as a church family, can intentionally turn our attention beyond our church walls and create opportunities to live that out. We'll also partner with our current teams and community groups to better equip and train us to engage missionally with those who don't know Jesus or aren't connected to a church. I'm excited to see how God uses this focus in the life of our church.

I'm also incredibly excited about the future of our youth ministries. Having a part-time staff member who is fully dedicated to our teens is a huge blessing—and even more so because of the person God has called to this role. Dena is a woman of strong character with a deep love for Jesus and a genuine passion for teenagers. Over the past 16 years of ministry, she has always been right by my side, faithfully serving and leading alongside me. I've never done youth ministry alone, and Dena has been an essential part of that journey.

She brings experience, wisdom, and a caring heart, and I'm confident our students will continue to be loved, supported, and challenged to grow in their faith. JV and Varsity will remain safe, welcoming places where students can deepen their relationship with God and with one another.

I want to invite all of us to pray—for Dena as she steps into this role, for our youth ministries, and for our students. Let's pray that God equips Dena and our leaders, softens hearts, and draws our students to know Him more fully and understand His character more deeply.

A Note from Dena

Hi church family!

I'm really looking forward to stepping into this role as Youth Director. For up to 15 hours each week, the first part of my role will be leading our Varsity youth group (high school students) on Wednesday nights, as well as organizing outreach opportunities and fun events with them.

Another part of my role is overseeing our JV ministry (middle school students) on Sundays. Anna Bilhorn does a fantastic job directing JV, and I'm excited to support her in any way I can. I'll also be responsible for organizing and planning mission trips and winter camps for our students.

As I step into this role, I'll be carrying on with the structure Zack has already put in place while I continue to pray, seek guidance, and discern a longer-term plan. Over the next four years with our students, I would love to walk through both the Old and New Testaments and tackle topics like sharing our faith, following Jesus in everyday life, spiritual disciplines, lament, identity in Christ, service projects, and why we believe what we believe. That last piece feels especially important, as wrestling with faith before graduation can shape how students carry their faith into adulthood.

Of course, we'll be sprinkling in plenty of fun too! I'd love to do things like concerts, Nerf wars, game nights, movie nights, and more.

Please be praying for our youth ministry and for leaders. We'll need adults to help on Wednesday nights, and I would love a mix of both younger and older leaders to walk alongside our students. If you're interested, please let me know—and thank you for praying for our youth.
