### Car Talk Youth Sunday School

Acts 11:1-18. Last week we learned how God's vision to Peter as well as the angel sent to Cornelius showed how there was no longer to be "clean" or "unclean" food or "clean" or "unclean" people. This week we see how some believers in Jerusalem struggled with this: they thought Gentiles needed to follow Jewish culture in order to be acceptable to God.

→ How did Peter persuade them? (He explained what happened, then described how the Holy Spirit came on the Gentile believers. "If, then, God gave them the same gift that he also gave to us when we believed in the Lord Jesus Christ, how could I possibly hinder God?" (11:17).

→ How did the Jews respond? (see 11:18).

→ How does it make you feel to know that God loves you and is willing to accept you?


