Car Talk Youth Sunday School

Acts 9:1-20. Paul (Saul) was on his way to Damascus to arrest people who followed Jesus when he saw a bright light and heard the voice of Jesus asking, "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me?" (9:4). He was suddenly blind. Meanwhile, the Lord came in a vision to Ananias.

- What did the Lord ask Ananias to do? Why was he afraid? (9:11-14).
- What plan did God have for Paul? (9:15) Who needs to hear the Good News about Jesus?
- If God could change Paul, who else can he change? In what ways would you like the Holy Spirit to change you?
