Targeted Audience(s)	Fulton Church participants and guests who participate in any church events. This includes children, parents, grandparents, relatives and visitors.
Guiding Principles and Values	To facilitate a safe and nurturing environment in which children and adults can grow in relationship with Jesus Christ.  The Safety Team will implement policies to safeguard program participants against emotional, physical or sexual abuse.
