### **A Moment for Missions**

News & prayer requests from a recent email:

Hello dear praying friends and family,

The past few months haven't been the easiest, personally or in terms of our host country and region. As you can probably imagine, the fighting in our region translates to stress in our community and in our lives. A recent news article I read talked about the "palpable tension" that our host country feels as we all watch and wait for what could be next. Sometimes something has to be named to be felt and reading that article helped me become aware of the heaviness we are all feeling as neighbors to this conflict. Would you join us here in praying for peace to come? And of course for those suffering through the worst this world can give. Lord, have mercy!

Another major burden here is the economy. We seem to be teetering on the edge of constant economic upheaval. People who would have been considered middle-class months ago are literally struggling to feed their families each day. So we watch and pray and share what we have. Lord, have mercy!

In our family, different ones have been struggling in their own unique ways. Isaiah (15) tore a ligament in his ankle during wrestling practice and that seemed to be a tipping point for both his emotional and physical health. We'd appreciate your prayers for him--for the recovery of his ankle, for the physical therapy he's doing to be effective and also for his emotional health. "The darkest night, You can light it up." Please pray with us for God to light up this dark night that Isaiah is walking through. Lord, have mercy!

I also joined the injured list at our house when I suffered a torn calf muscle in the midst of a pickleball game. I was bedridden for about 5 days and have slowly been improving since early February. The same physical therapist Isaiah has will work with me but I still need a clear ultrasound to "graduate" to PT. Please pray that my recovery would be complete. Shortly after my injury, I got sick and have still not fully recovered. The air pollution here is at its worst in February and my coughing is constantly irritated by the pollution and dust. It's been a difficult month of injury and illness and I'd love it to be over!



Joel is starting a new partnership with an organization that runs camps here. In December, we traveled to a family camp hosted by this organization so we could start to understand the work they do and also see how we could use our gifts effectively in this partnership. Because my co-leader is currently out of the country, I won't begin any work with this organization until April, but Joel's work has already started. Please pray for his relationships with the group of leaders he will be working with, for his language skills to grow significantly and quickly in this new environment and for the families he will serve through this new partnership.

My trauma work continues and I currently have four people I work with every week, plus two more who have asked to work with me in the past week. In addition to my leadership responsibilities, my own language growth and my studies/supervision requirements for my trauma credentials, 6 people in a week feels like a lot! Please pray for these individuals to experience the healing God desires for them as we journey together. Please pray for my stamina and emotional reserves as I spend time listening to difficult stories and attuning to the suffering of others.

Summer 2024: We are currently working on travel details and planning but we hope to be in the US from the second week of June until the end of August. We hope to see as many of you in person as we can!




