

Car Talk Youth Sunday School

1 Corinthians 12. We have been learning about the spread of the Church in Acts, but today's lesson comes from Paul's letter to the church at Corinth. Members of that church needed to be reminded 1) that whether Jew or Gentile, slave or free is not relevant within the body (v13), and 2) that members of the body have different spiritual gifts which we should use to glorify God and build each other up as followers of God (v7). Our curriculum asks:

- Why does God give Christians spiritual gifts?
- Why do we need *different* spiritual gifts?
- What gifts do you have that you could use to worship God and build up others in church?


