Responsibilities and Leadership Values

Responsibilities of a Church Council Member:

1. Acts as the legal officers and final authority of Fulton Church, and as such, shall be empowered to do all things necessary or convenient for the orderly and efficient administration of the affairs and the business of Fulton Church, under the direction and guidance of the Holy Spirit within the framework of this constitution and its intent.
2. Responsible for the vision and strategies for Fulton Church aligned with the values and objectives of scripture, taking into consideration the desires of the membership, as well as the needs of our membership, surrounding communities, and our world.
3. Responsible for advancing the purpose of the church. Growing in Christ, Connecting as a church family and Reaching out to the world so we continue to be a "light in the country".
4. All other responsibilities as outlined in Article VII 3 b of the Church Constitution

Leadership Values of a Church Council Member:

1. We value leadership qualities modeled on the person of Christ (1 Timothy 3:8-13) that characterizes a life above reproach and trustworthiness.
2. We value servant leadership modeled on the person of Christ in the gospels (Matthew 12:18) that is humble and transparent, built on trust and unity through the wisdom and inspiration of the Holy Spirit and the scriptures.
3. We value shepherd leadership modeled on the person of Christ (John 10:1-21) that seeks to put the needs of others above the needs of themselves.
4. We value personal leadership that employs methods of coaching, mentoring, facilitating, and consensus-building.
5. We value leadership empowering individuals with God-given talents in ownership of their roles and responsibilities.
6. We DO NOT value leadership styles that rely on command and control, which is autocratic in nature, and based on positional (or personal) power and authority.
7. We DO NOT value leadership that sees any person as something less than God's creation - seeing others as "something to be managed" rather than a fellow sister or brother in Christ.

Leadership Goal of Fulton Church:

Fulton Church leadership's goal is to prepare God's people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up until we all reach a unity in faith and knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ (Ephesians 4:12-13).

This is not an all-inclusive list of responsibilities, but includes those responsibilities most accountable to the role of Church Council Member.
