

New Women's Bible Study


How much have you considered your eternal home? When we talk of heaven there can be many questions. Who will be there? Where is it? What will we do there?



Car Talk Youth Sunday School

Acts 9:31-43.

→ What did Peter do for Aeneas, the paralyzed man? In whose power was he able to do this?

→ What did Peter do for the friends of Tabitha (Dorcas)? (v40-41: He raised her back to life to rejoin her friends.)

→ How did this change the people who saw the results of these miracles? ("many believed")

This passage gives us a window on the future Kingdom: 1) restored health, 2) restored relationships with each other, 3) restored relationship with God. It also gives us a window on what the Church looked like in the past: "So the church...had peace and was strengthened. Living in the fear of the Lord and encouraged by the Holy Spirit, it increased in numbers" (9:31). Can we experience that now? If so, how?
